WINDING DOWN THE YEAR

The theme of newsletters these past few weeks has been getting ready for next year but the next planting season may be sooner than you think. This fall and winter we will be experimenting with extending our growing season using several different season extension methods. We plan on planting the hoop houses and double-covering the cold weather crops we are going to plant in there. In the large greenhouse, the plants will have the benefit of some extra heat and grow lights to give them the temperatures and hours of

“sunlight” they need to grow. Look for information on a potential winter CSA in the coming weeks.
